GUIDELINES FOR CHANGING ROOMS AND SHOWERING FACILITIES

Note: The terms 'child' and 'young person' describe any person under the age of 18. References to 'parents' should be read as parents and carers inclusively.

Normandy Cricket Club adheres to the ECB guidelines on the use of changing rooms and showering facilities.

These guidelines apply to the arrangements to be made for adults and children, using changing facilities. It is a safeguarding requirement that children and adults must not use the changing facilities at the same time.

BEST PRACTICE PRINCIPLES

Adults must not change, or shower, at the same time using the same facility as children.

If adults and children need to share a changing facility, then they must do so at different times.

If children feel uncomfortable changing or showering at the Club, no pressure should be put on them to do so. Suggest instead that they may change and shower at home.

Mixed gender teams must have access to separate male and female changing rooms

Due to the risks of inappropriate photography or filming, mobile phones must not be used in changing rooms.
